

## Mysticism and Social Concern: A Day of Quiet Reflection in Honor of Evelyn Underhill

### Overview

In her life and through her writing, Evelyn Underhill began with a sense of both prayer and worship as almost solely a personal encounter with the Divine. But eventually she was moved to understand how all of this is intended, within the Christian context, to move one into concern and action in issues of justice in society. The Day will focus on Evelyn Underhill's blending of personal prayer, corporate worship and social justice into a coherent life, one accessible to others through her writing. In addition to two presentations, the Day, which runs from 9-3:30 p.m., will offer opportunities for private prayer, corporate silence and Eucharist.

**The Reverend Canon Dr. Gerald Loweth** is retired from parochial ministry which took him from Connecticut to Hawaii to Toronto and which engaged him with social issues, particularly housing for the poor. He continues to lead workshops and quiet days, is spiritual director for theological students at Trinity College, University of Toronto, and is preparing to teach a course on urban ministry. He is married to Elizabeth Ockenden Loweth and has four grown children and eight grandchildren.

**Kathleen Henderson Staudt (Kathy)** teaches at the Cathedral College, Wesley and Virginia Theological Seminaries and the University of Maryland. She is a poet and spiritual director and author of *Annunciations: Poems out of Scripture*.
